

1 Purpose of the document

The instructions are part of the Duravit product. Failure to follow the instructions may result in personal injury, product damage and/or property damage.

2 Avoiding damage

If the cleaning intervals are too long, this may lead to soiling that is difficult to remove

- > Regularly clean the surface and clean immediately if soiled.

Incorrect cleaning agents, cleaning tools and cleaning equipment can damage the surface and permanently discolour it.

- > Only use cleaning agents and cleaning tools recommended by Duravit.
- > Do NOT use the following cleaning agents:
 - Acidic cleaning agent (pH < 6) (e.g. lemon-based cleaner)
 - Chlorine-based cleaning agent (e.g. toilet cleaner)
- > Follow the cleaning agent manufacturer's instructions for use.
- > Only use cleaning equipment that is intended for the application (NO high-pressure washers or steam cleaning machines).

Abrasive cleaning agents can leave shiny marks on matt surfaces.

- > Do NOT use the following cleaning agents:
 - Abrasive cleaning agent (e.g. abrasive cleaner, polish)
- > Clean without pressure.

UV radiation can permanently discolour the surface.

> Avoid direct and continuous sunlight.

Spray can penetrate into very small openings and gaps and damage the surface.

> Spray the spray cleaner onto the cleaning cloth and not directly onto the product.

3 Cleaning

> Clean the surface with a damp cleaning cloth.

> Remove heavier soiling with the recommended cleaning agent. Always apply the cleaning agent to the cleaning cloth.

> Rinse with clean water to remove all traces of the cleaning agent.

> Dry the surface.

4 Recommended cleaning agents

Daily cleaning	Water	Cotton cleaning cloth
Coated and lacquered surfaces (coloured)	Neutral cleaning agent (pH 6 – 8) (e.g. neutral cleaner)	Cotton cleaning cloth
Chrome	Neutral cleaning agent (pH 6 – 8) (e.g. neutral cleaner)	Cotton cleaning cloth
